Important Information

Working on Sundays and public holidays

Work is permitted on Sundays and Public Holidays during the trade fair period in accordance with § 10 para. 1, No. 9 of the Arbeitszeitgesetz [= Working Hours Act]. It is not necessary to obtain approval from the authorities for activities within the trade fair grounds. Attention is drawn to the compensation rules, § 11 of the Working Hours Act.

Night work

If it is necessary to carry out work outside the opening hours for exhibitors, you need a night working permit for the personnel involved and if required for a vehicle. With this permission work may be carried out up to midnight. You must apply for it duly before nightwork is to commence. Therefore please contact the "Sicherheitsleitzentrale" (ground floor of the container complex next to Gate 2). Upon presentation of your identity card and the stand owner's written order, you will receive the relevant night working permit at the Sicherheitsleitzentrale.

For security reasons, stand cleaning outside the opening hours for exhibitors can only be carried out by our service partner. Therefore no night working permit will be issued for stand cleaning outside the opening hours for exhibitors!

Photography and Filming Permit

Photography and filming on the exhibition grounds and in the halls is permitted in accordance with the relevant legal provisions (GDPR, general personal rights, etc.). Visitors and other third parties must not be impaired in the process. Escape and rescue routes must be kept clear. Within the scope of their domiciliary rights, exhibitors are entitled to issue a ban on filming and photography for their own stand. This must be marked accordingly.

Photographing and filming of your own stand outside event opening times requires a special permit. On presentation of your identity card and written application from the owner of the stand you will receive the photography and filming permit at the security control centre (Sicherheitszentrale). This permit is valid for a specific day until a fixed time (max. until 12 midnight).

The photography and filming permit costs € 61.50/night per person.
